
TEACHING EXPERIENCE

PILLARS OF MY PRIVATE ACTING INSTRUCTION

Personalized, focused and fun exploration!

SCENE AND TEXT ANALYSIS

I like to provide my students with a practical guide to breaking down any scene by investigating the given circumstances in the play and asking four essential questions. I touch on techniques and practices used by the American masters who expanded on Konstantin Stanislavki's Method, and provide a foundation to break down fun, age-appropriate scenes together. Students will learn to:

- Identify the given circumstances within the play to help enhance one's understanding of the character.
- Examine the "moment before" the scene begins, and the present state of the character.
- Break down a scene into units, which start and end with a shift in the character's objective.
- Attach meaning to the character's objective and discuss how not fulfilling that need or want might impact the gravity of the scene and the life of the character in the play.
- Learn to track Obstacles and methods of action within a scene, crafting an interesting journey for the character that will captivate an audience.
- For more advanced or curious students, I introduce text and the techniques of Sanford Meisner and Uta Hagen, in addition to passages from the father of naturalism, Konstantin Stanislavski.

PHYSICALITY IN CHARACTERIZATION

How much can you tell an audience about a character before even uttering a word? Using techniques developed by Mary Overlie, Anne Bogart, Tina Landau, Frederick Matthias Alexander and Rudy Laban, students learn to craft a characterizations through movement and gesture.

- Create an awareness of one's body, using a warm-up developed by the National Theatre's movement director.
- Discuss the Six Viewpoints space, shape, time, emotion, movement, and story developed by choreographer Mary Overlie and adapted for use in staging theatre by Anne Bogart and Tina Landau. We'll also introduce some practices developed by Frederick Matthias Alexander in Australia in the 1890s, and the movement principles of Rudolph Laban.
- Play improv games utilizing different modes, methods and tempos to help craft a character's physicality and mannerisms.
- Practice active observation, drawing conclusions about characters using their physical cues.

VOCAL TRANSFORMATION IN CHARACTERIZATION

Explored through Animation Voiceover and Dialect Work

Students expand their vocal range and expressiveness, and get to try their hand at crafting characters from animated series using sides from Cartoon Network, Nickelodeon and the Disney Channel! This curriculum can be expanded to include other sects of the exciting and sprawling voice acting world!

- Students will learn how to expand their breath support and safely warm up their voices.
- Learn microphone technique and sound booth etiquette, as well as key terminology.
- Learn to make bold, defining choices to differentiate animated characters using sides from Craig
 of the Creek, Harvey Beaks, The Fancies and other animated films and series from Disney,
 Nickelodeon and the Cartoon Network.
- For students who really love vocal transformation, I offer accent and dialect coaching in:
 - American Southern
 - British RP or New Standard English
 - Cockney
 - o Irish
 - French
 - Italian
 - Russian
 - New York, and more!



ACTING FOR TELEVISION AND FILM

How can you adapt your compelling performances for the silver screen? What is the difference between acting on-camera in television episodics and film, and acting in the theatre? What technical terminologies should I know before stepping onto set? We'll get you ready for your close up!


- For students curious about acting for on-camera, we discuss camera angles & adjusting for frame.
- Analyze the structure of an on-camera script vs. a play for the theatre.
- Learn important terminology and shooting styles, like Multi-cam vs Single Cam.
- Sessions will utilize age-appropriate on-camera sides from various produced episodics.

ACTING THROUGH SONG

Characters sing when the moment is so crucial and emotionally charged that merely speaking isn't enough to convey what they are feeling. For musically gifted students who wisho make their repertoire really sing, we'll break down the text together and craft an expressive performance that gives insight into the character's internal life, and charts their wants and struggles in a way that will be understandable and moving to an audience.



- Clarify a character's relationship to the other people in the scene.
- Identify the character's immediate need, what obstacles stand in their way and what actions the character takes throughout the song to overcome them.
- Find moments within the song to outwardly pursue and inwardly reflect.
- Look for musical cues within the score to help shape the character's journey.

MONOLOGUE MASTERY AND REPERTOIRE BUILDING

Without the aid of a scene partner, performance of solo texts can be challenging, and yet monologues are necessary tools for young actors wishing to enter the industry. I like to arm my students with repertoire of age appropriate speeches, and work together to craft compelling and clear performances using the given circumstances in the play and practices derived from Stanislavky's core elements.

- Identify the given circumstances within the play to help enhance one's understanding of the character.
- Examine the "moment before," and the state and mood of the character at the start off the speech.
- Identify shifts in objective, creating units to help navigate the piece.
- Track Obstacles and Methods within the piece. Conjuring up what the imagined response of the speech would be if one were onstage with a partner, creating hurdles that make the character's journey more interesting.
- Attach meaning to the character's objective and discuss how not fulfilling that need or want
 might impact the life of the character in the play.

All of the above curriculum is personalized to suit the interests and talents of each young performer. I love to create a nurturing and fun enrivonment in which to explore new principles. Coachings for specific auditions or college admissions are also offered.

DETAILED PERFORMANCE BIOGRAPHY

Sean Patrick Doyle's Broadway credits include the Tony-winning tuners Kinky Boots and La Cage Aux Folles. Off-Broadway, his work in Jerry Springer: The Opera (New Group) earned him a Lucille Lortel Nomination for Outstanding Featured Actor. Other Off-Broadway credits include Anna Nicole: The Opera (BAM), Volpone and The Tempest (Red Bull) and Wig Out! (Vineyard Theatre). National and International tours include Mary Poppins, Fiddler on the Roof, West Side Story, Fame: The Musical. Regionally, his work has garnered MAC, SALT and Carbonell nominations for Best Actor. On screen, he is best known for his turn as roller skating lackey Garv in 20th Century Fox's The Sitter, opposite Oscar-nominee Jonah Hill and Oscar-winner Sam Rockwell. Other film credits include Netflix's Barack Obama biopic Barry, and the Academy Award nominated animated feature The Boxtrolls, for which he provided singing vocals for Oscar winner Sir Ben Kingsley. Television: Fosse/Verdon, Nurse Jackie, Donny!, Gotham, Forever, Law & Order and Mamma Dallas (pilot for HBO). He holds his Masters from the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art (RADA) in London.
